place at four museums and historic sites administered by the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum

Commission. At

[Landis Valley Museum](#), visitors are immersed in authentic PA Dutch rural life. The village and farm museum includes many historic buildings and

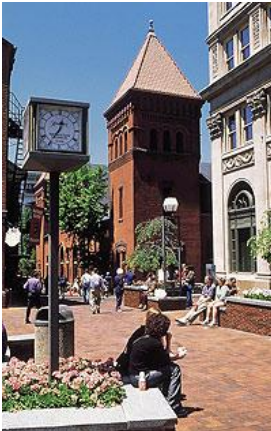
landscapes, heritage-breed farm animals and gardens and diverse collections of more than 10,000 early farm, trade and household objects. At [The Railroad Museum of Pennsylvania](#) you can sit in an engineer’s seat, climb aboard a caboose, and inspect a 62-ton locomotive from underneath. Discover the fascinating heritage of the industry that



built our nation. More than 100 historic locomotives and railroad cars are preserved in the world-class collection, their stories—and the stories of the railroading men and women—are told through beautiful displays. [The Ephrata Cloister](#) has welcomed visitors for over 260 years. Founded in 1732, Ephrata was a protestant monastic community of celibate Brothers and Sisters supported by a married congregation who lived near the settlement. Today, nine original buildings are part of a 28-acre complex open for visitors. [Cornwall Iron Furnace](#) was once the heart of a thriving iron plantation (1742-1883). There were many such furnaces dotting the PA landscape but this is the only cold blast iron furnace to survive intact in the Western Hemisphere. Visit the site where iron was made into cannon for the Continental Army during America's War for Independence. All four historical sites have just a single admission price. Or, your chapter may choose to check out other historical activities in the area such as the former bachelor-President [James Buchanan's Wheatland](#), historic downtown [Strasburg](#). After all your historical site seeing, the ladies can come back to **The Black Horse** and relax in one of our guest rooms or chat about your day over dinner in our restaurant.
